HEARTS ON FIRE at Sacred Heart

Where Faith is Known,
Lived, & Shared

I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing. (Luke 12:49)

As you read the Archbishop’s letter, based on Synod 16, ask yourselves, “What is the Holy Spirit saying to me?”

LISTEN to the Archbishop: GUIDEPOST 1—THE NEW PENTECOST (cont.) — For the Church in Detroit, reliving the Gospel mysteries means that we continually return to the Upper Room, asking for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit on us and on the whole region. We seek to bring every member of the Church, insofar as possible, into a personal and life-transforming experience of the Holy Spirit. Recognizing that we cannot give what we do not have, we continually seek to be re-freshed in God’s presence and filled again and again with his love, so that it is his own love we are giving away.

Come, Holy Spirit, to us at Sacred Heart Church and to the Church in Detroit. We continually seek you in the Upper Room, asking for a “fresh outpouring of your Holy Spirit on us and on the whole region.” Guide us in bringing every member of the Church to you for a “personal and life-transforming experience” with you. Pour into us all that we need and humbly acknowledge that we do not have, to do your work in the world. 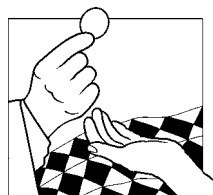

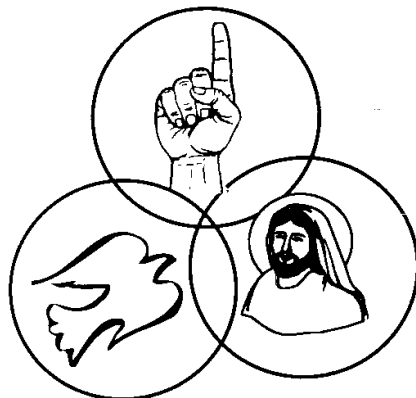
