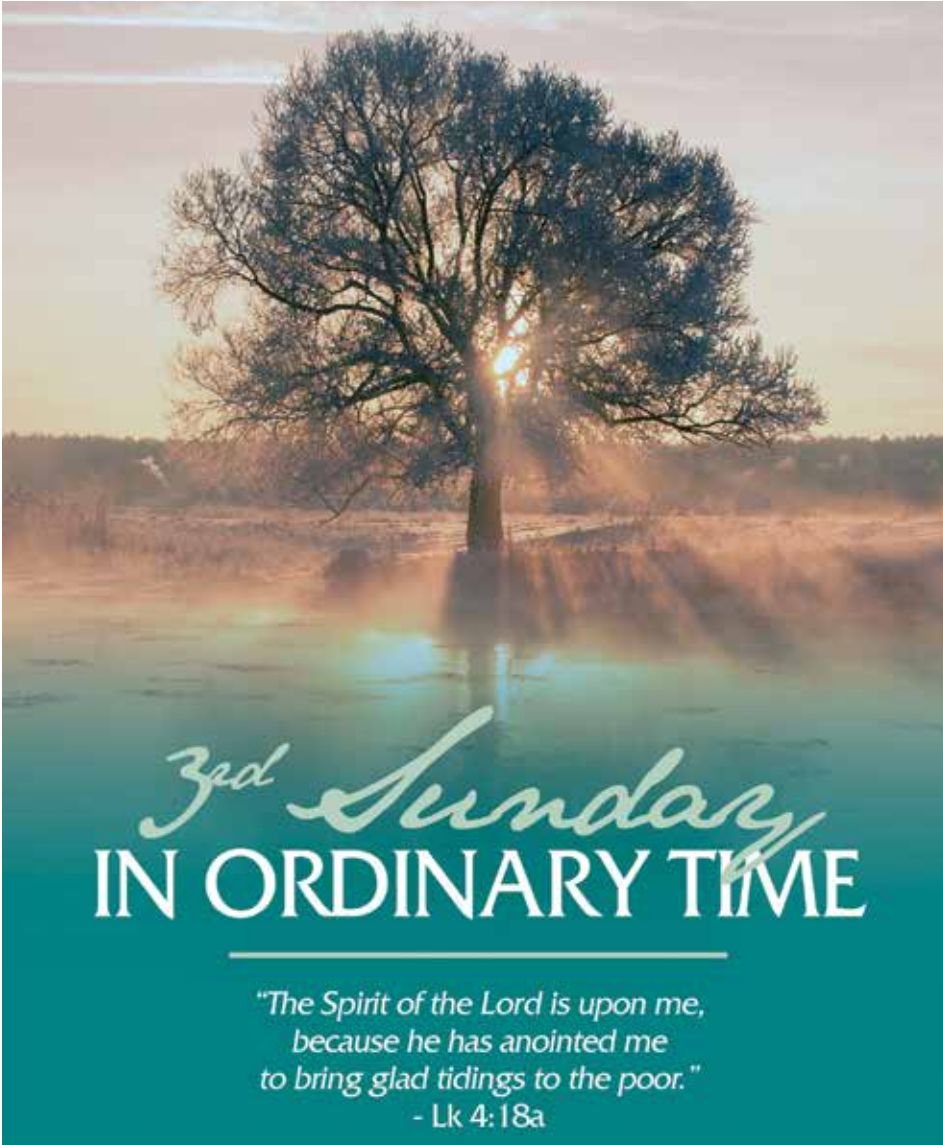

HEARTS ON FIRE at Sacred Heart

Where Faith is Known,
Lived, & Shared

I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing. (Luke 12:49)

As you read the Archbishop’s letter, based on Synod 16, ask yourselves, “What is the Holy Spirit saying to me?”

LISTEN to the Archbishop: GUIDEPOST 4—EQUIPPING FOR THE SERVICE OF THE GOSPEL; Marker 4.1 Evangelizing the Evangelizers—To become an effective evangelizer one must first be evangelized, since we cannot give away what we do not have. Thus an urgent priority is to ensure that those who are to invite others to Christ have a deep personal relationship with Christ themselves. Some signs of this relationship are: receiving the sacraments regularly; engaging in personal prayer every day; reading Scripture daily; constantly learning more about the faith and seeking to live by it; and engaging in long-term regular service activities.

PRAY: *Tear or cut off this prayer and keep it where you’ll remember to pray it throughout the week*

Come, Holy Spirit, to us at Sacred Heart Church and inspire each of us into a “deep personal relationship with Christ” precisely so that we will be “effective evangelizers” enabling us to then “invite others to Christ.” Lead us into living those “signs of [such a] relationship” so that others may see what we have and want it for themselves. Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Amen
