# HEARTS ON FIRE at Sacred Heart

## Where Faith is Known, Lived, & Shared

*I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing. (Luke 12:49)*

As you read the Archbishop’s letter, based on Synod 16, ask yourselves, “What is the Holy Spirit saying to me?”

**LISTEN to the Archbishop: GUIDEPOST 4—EQUIPPING FOR THE SERVICE OF THE GOSPEL; Marker 4.3 Charisms**—The [Vatican II] Council also instructed that priests, “While testing the spirits to see if they be of God (cf. 1 John 4:1), ...should uncover with a sense of faith, acknowledge with joy and foster with diligence the various humble and exalted charisms of the laity.” Discerning and pastoring the use of charisms is one of the most challenging and yet rewarding aspects of ecclesial leadership. Priests, deacons and lay ecclesial ministers in the Archdiocese should consider how to foster the use of charisms and to make all their evangelistic and pastoral endeavors “charism-based.” When discerning to whom the leadership of a particular ministry should be entrusted, or who should be called upon to volunteer, we must seek as much as possible to match people’s responsibilities to their charisms.

**PRAY:** *Tear or cut off this prayer and keep it where you’ll remember to pray it throughout the week*

*Come, Holy Spirit, to us at Sacred Heart Church. Lead all who are in leadership in our parish into discerning their own charisms and those of others. Show them how to “foster the use of charisms” and “make all their evangelistic and pastoral endeavors ‘charism-based.’” Enable them by Your grace to seek to match people’s responsibilities to their charisms. Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Amen*

**ACT:** What is this letter saying to you? What are you doing to build the Church at Sacred Heart? Are you doing anything? Is it just the “least” you can do? Or do you believe you have a gift, a “charism” from the Holy Spirit to do it, even if it is a small thing? Remember we were all given them and have a duty to use them. Pray for the Holy Spirit to show you what your God-given Charism is/are. Consider seeking out and taking a Called and Gifted workshop in the area to help with that. Look for opportunities to use it (or them) at Sacred Heart—Pastoral Associate Mike Merlo could help you find a “match”.

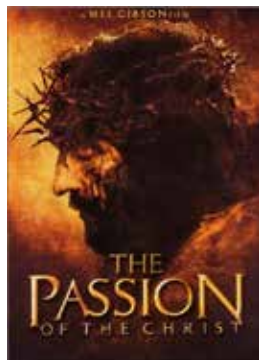
