

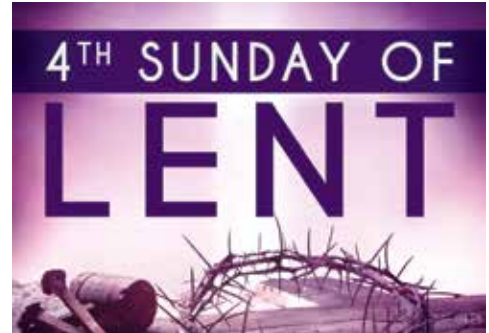

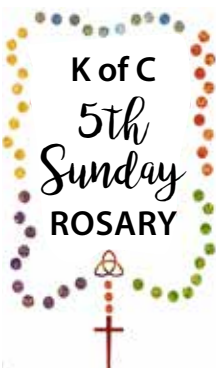

HEARTS ON FIRE at Sacred Heart

Where Faith is Known,
Lived, & Shared

I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing. (Luke 12:49)

As you read the Archbishop’s letter, based on Synod 16, ask yourselves, “What is the Holy Spirit saying to me?”

LISTEN to the Archbishop: GUIDEPOST 4—EQUIPPING FOR THE SERVICE OF THE GOSPEL; Marker 4.3 Charisms —(cont) [The Vatican Council II also instructed us to] give people room to grow and flourish in the use of their gifts, as St. John Chrysostom counsels: “The most basic task of a church leader is to discern the spiritual gifts of all those under his authority, and to encourage those gifts to be used to the full benefit of all. Only a person who can discern the gifts of others and can humbly rejoice in the flourishing of those gifts is fit to lead the Church.”

PRAY: *Tear or cut off this prayer and keep it where you’ll remember to pray it throughout the week*

Come, Holy Spirit, to us at Sacred Heart Church. May you form us into a parish that gives people “room to grow and flourish in the use of their gifts.” Guide all of our parish leaders to “discern the spiritual gifts of all those under their authority,” and may they “humbly rejoice in the flourishing of those gifts.” Inspire in each of us the desire and the will to discern our own Charisms so that we can use them to build your Church. “Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Amen

ACT: What is this letter saying to you? We have been considering “charisms” these last few weeks. It should be obvious now that 1) everyone (including you) were given them at your Baptism; 2) they have been given to each of us by God, not to keep, but specifically to use for the building of His Church; 3) we have a duty to use them for this purpose; 4) It’s hard to use them if we don’t know what they are. Continue to pray for the Holy Spirit to show you what your Charism(s) is/are. Check out www.siena.org for information about Charisms and discerning them. Ask others what they think yours might be. Look for opportunities to use it (or them) at Sacred Heart Parish—Pastoral Associate Mike Merlo could help you find a “match”.

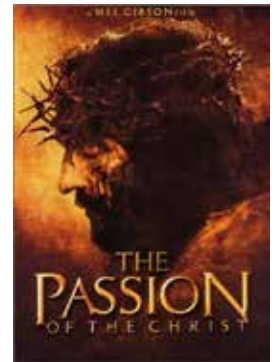
