HEARTS ON FIRE at Sacred Heart

Where Faith is Known, Lived, & Shared

I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing. (Luke 12:49)

As you read the Archbishop's letter, based on Synod 16, ask yourselves, "What is the Holy Spirit saying to me?"

LISTEN to the Archbishop: GUIDEPOST 5 - NO BYSTANDERS: Marker 5.1: The Laity— The special calling and privilege of the lay faithful is to bring Christ into the secular world. "Since the laity, in accordance with their state of life, live in the midst of the world and its concerns, they are called by God to exercise their apostolate in the world like leaven, with the ardor of the spirit of Christ." Their role is to transform every aspect of the culture through the Gospel—family life, education, government, business, the media, entertainment, sports, science, the arts. They do so both by "engaging in temporal affairs and ordering them according to the plan of God" and by "revealing Christ by word to those around them.

PRAY: *Tear or cut off this prayer and keep it where you'll remember to pray it throughout the week*

Come, Holy Spirit, to the lay faithful at Sacred Heart Church. Give us strength and courage to "bring Christ into the secular world." Lead us into transforming through the Gospel every aspect of our particular sphere of influence in our culture. Reveal to us how to engage and order these temporal affairs "according to the plan of God" and to "reveal Christ by word" to those around us. "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Amen

ACT: What is this letter saying to you? Do you hear God's "special calling" to YOU? Consider what are your primary spheres of influence in your life—family, work, sports, etc. How might you "engage" them and "order them to the plan of God"? Try using "Jesus" or "God" in a conversation this week.

NATIONAL HISTORIAN TO DISCUSS CANONIZATION

The Detroit Chapter of Christ Child Society is pleased to welcome Patty Myler, Historian and Canonization Advisory Board Member of the National Christ Child Society as their Evening of Reflection keynote speaker.

The event will take place Tuesday, April 30 at Holy Name Church in Birmingham, Michigan. Myler has been an active member of the Washington, DC Chapter since 1980 and has been on the front lines of the Mary Virginia Merrick canonization cause.

Mary Virginia Merrick was a native of Washington, DC, founder of the National Christ Child Society and is a candidate for canonization in the Catholic Church. Despite becoming paralyzed following a fall while a teenager, she transformed and inspired thousands of people through her deep love for the Christ Child and her Catholic faith.

Central to "Miss Mary's" spirituality and her ministry was the Incarnation of Christ as an infant.

Her service to the poor and vulnerable was based on her own devotion to the Christ Child and her belief that anything asked of Him for a child would be given.

Myler will share insights on Merrick's impact on our world, her legacy being fulfilled through hundreds of Christ Child chapters and the cause to have Mary Virginia Merrick canonized.

The evening will begin at 6:30 pm with mass being offered by Detroit Chapter Spiritual Advisor and Holy Name Pastor, Monsignor John P. Zenz. Myler's presentation will follow and include an opportunity for questions and answers. A light reception will follow.
