HEARTS ON FIRE at Sacred Heart

I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing. (Luke 12:49)

As you read the Archbishop’s letter, based on Synod 16, ask yourselves, “What is the Holy Spirit saying to me?”

LISTEN to the Archbishop: GUIDEPOST 5 - NO BYSTANDERS: Marker 5.1: The Laity (cont)—The engagement of every lay person, according to their gifts and state in life, is essential for the mission of the Church to be fulfilled. “Each member of the lay faithful should always be fully aware of being a ‘member of the Church’ yet entrusted with a unique task which cannot be done by another and which is to be fulfilled for the good of all.” Each one should reflect on how the Lord is calling them to bring the Gospel into their particular spheres of influence both through their deeds and their words.

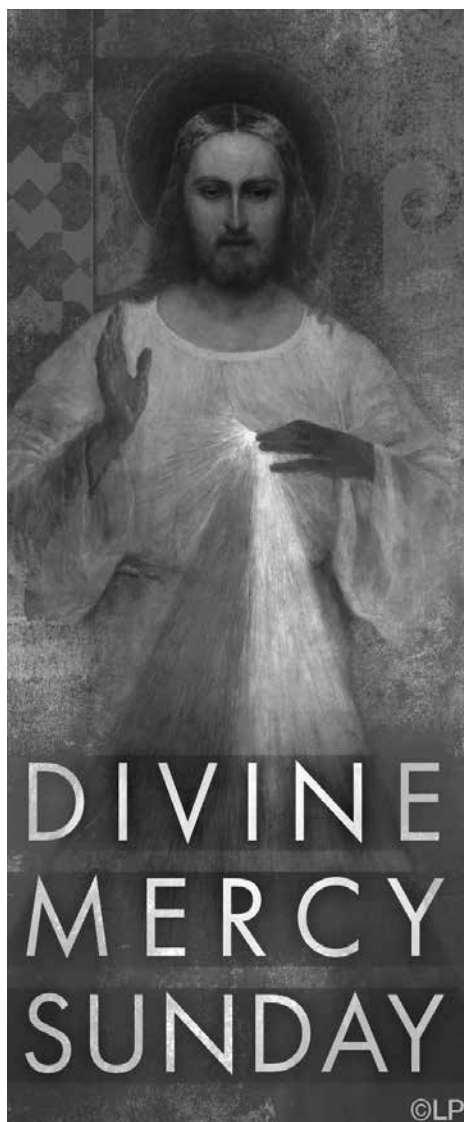
