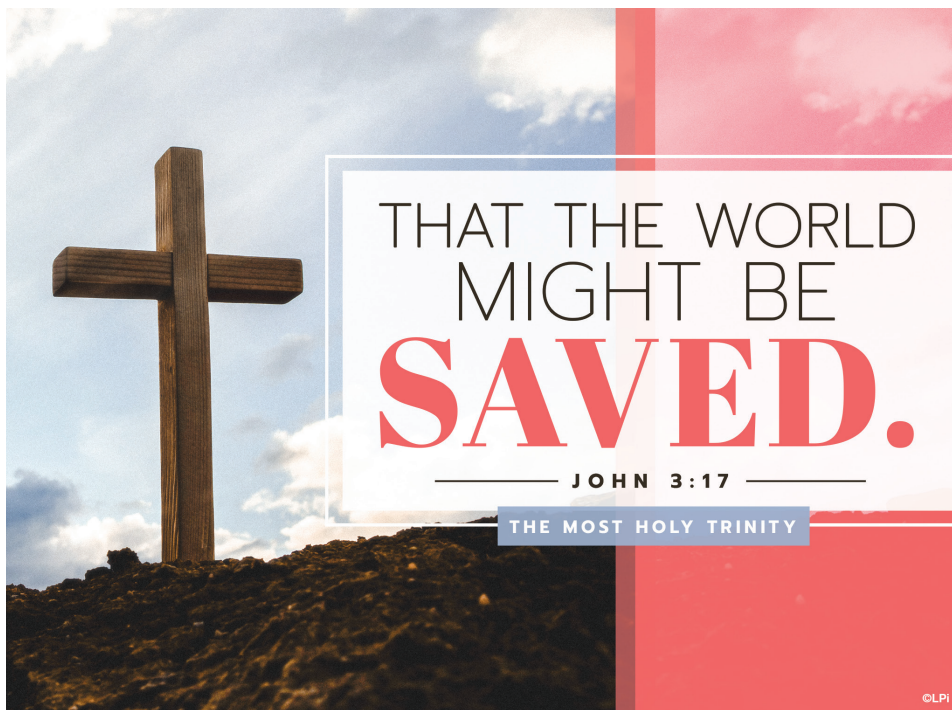

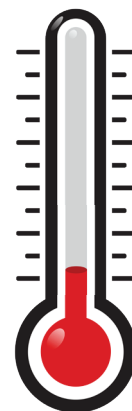

**LISTEN to POPE BENEDICT XVI: Authentic Participation**—The Council went on to say that the faithful "should be instructed by God's word, and nourished at the table of the Lord's Body. They should give thanks to God. Offering the immaculate Victim, not only through the hands of the priest but also together with him, they should learn to make an offering of themselves. Through Christ, the Mediator, they should be drawn day by day into an ever more perfect union with God and each other."

**PRAY: Throughout the week and on Pentecost** . . . Come Holy Spirit, come! Open our hearts and minds to receive the gifts You offer us in the Mass, that we may be instructed by Your Word, and "nourished at the table of Your Body." Teach us to make an offering of ourselves, along with You, together with the priest. Draw us into an "ever more perfect union with You and with each other." Amen!

**ASK & ACT:** What are these words saying to **ME**? Have I considered that I am being "instructed" by God's word, and "nourished" at the "table of the Lord's Body"? Have I used that instruction and nourishment in my everyday life? How, or how can I do better? Have I made an offering of myself, together with Christ, at His table? And has that drawn me into an "ever more perfect union with God and with others"? What would that look like, if it were so? I will pray for the Holy Spirit to work in me to make it so, and reveal to me how I am to better live it out.

## Living the Mystery of the Trinity by John Hannigan

Recently we've reflected on aspects of the Holy Spirit, that *Spirit of Truth* promised by Jesus, sent by the Father, and poured into us in the Sacraments. The Spirit who empowers the Church to go forth on mission, effects our adoption as children of God, and bestows gifts that yield spiritual fruit. Those Fruits of the Spirit, "*perfections that the Holy Spirit forms in us as the first fruits of eternal glory*" (CCC¶1832), include love, joy, patience, kindness and generosity (Gal 5:22-23), exactly those characteristics of persons that make living peacefully in community possible.

Today, the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**, we consider the Mystery of the Triune God. Since we are created in the "*image and likeness*" of God (Gen 1:26-27), we reflect, imperfectly, the divine attributes of rationality, free will, and the capacity to love. Pope Benedict XVI emphasized "*relationship*" within the Trinity as another key attribute we share. *Communion* among persons is fundamental to the "character" of the Holy Spirit as the third person of the Trinity, that perfect unity of persons defined by love, for "*God is love*" (1 John 4:8). St. Augustine viewed the Holy Spirit also as the love between the Father and the Son. Our communion with others in this life is a faint image of how we will be united with the Trinity in the next. In the unity of the Trinity, and by the Fruits of the Holy Spirit, we intuit how we are made to relate to one another. It is in imitation of *relationality* within the Trinity – that consubstantiality among Father, Son and Holy Spirit – that we are made to be united with the one God and embraced by the communion of saints.

In today's second reading (2 Cor 13:11-13), St. Paul greets the Christians in Corinth directing them first to rejoice, and praying that "*the God of love and peace will be with*" them. He calls them to heal their relationships, mend their divisive ways, "*encourage one another,*" and to live together amicably, in agreement and peace. Then Paul blesses them with: "*The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.*" In invoking the Trinity, Paul is praying that the divine attribute of communion, the love within the Trinity, be shared among us, and that we live in a fellowship of grace, peace, and love.

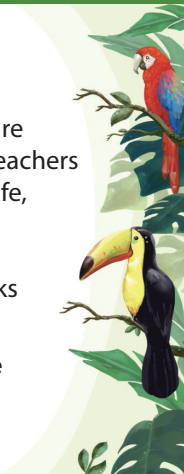

Our parish has been selected by the Archdiocese for a designated mission appeal on June 6-7th.

We welcome Fr. Luis Geovanny Arbelaez, a visiting priest from the Institute of The Incarnate Word's mission, who will share the important work being done to serve the poor and marginalized around the world at all Masses next week, June 6th & 7th.



The Institute of the Incarnate Word's mission is to form our members in Human and Christian maturity to become missionaries who would inculturate the Gospel in the diversity of cultures. We care for the disabled, the elderly, and the sick, provide homes for the poor and for abandoned children, manage schools and educational institutions in rural areas in developing countries, and promote pastoral formation of our missionaries related to human, intellectual, and spiritual development. Present in 45 countries, our most challenging missions are in Argentina, Bolivia, Ecuador, Guyana, Iraq, Palestine (Gaza), Papua New Guinea, Peru, Syria, Tajikistan, Tanzania, and Ukraine among others. The collected funds will benefit the children, the elderly, the sick, the poor, the abandoned, the handicapped, and the suffering. Your help will be used for the day-to-day support for missionaries, to supply material goods such as food, water, and medicine, to support pastoral works, to purchase vehicles to arrive to remote rural areas where there are no roads. to build seminaries and churches, and to provide hope where the Catholic faith is a minority or does not exist at all for the enrichment of the evangelization program around the world. 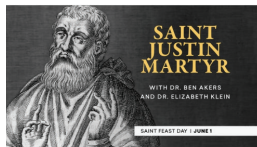

Our hope is not only that young people learn about the Holy Spirit, but that they encounter Him personally—and discover that when the Spirit moves, everything changes.

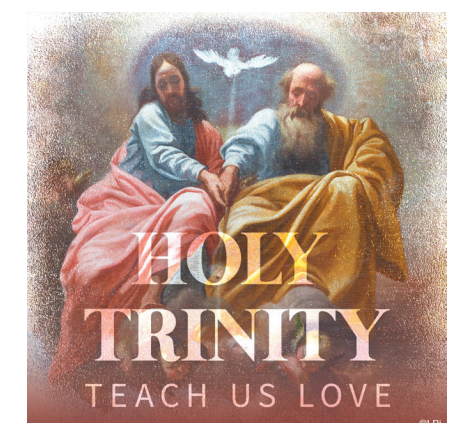

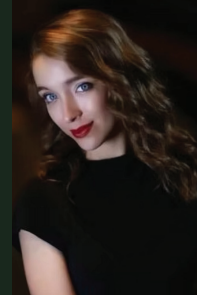

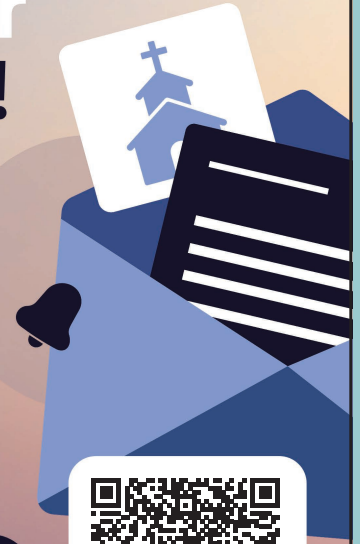
